

Data Protection Notice

This notice provides you with information on how the journal “Innovation – The European Journal of Social Science Research, owned by “The European Association of the Advancement of the Social Sciences in cooperation with the TUB and the nexus Institute Berlin and published by Routledge („we“) will process your personal data.

The data protection declaration of both, the European Association (<https://europeanassociation.eu/data-protection-declaration/>) and of Taylor&Francis (<https://taylorandfrancis.com/customer-privacy/>) apply for the Journal as well.

1. Purposes for which we process your data

We will process your personal data set out in Point 2 below for the following purposes:

- a) to inform you about our activities;
- b) to allow cooperation for publications and research notes;
- c) to fulfil the needs of ongoing electronic correspondence; and
- d) all other related activities.

We collect this data from former and ongoing common activities, e.g. former correspondence, former cooperation, etc..

The provision of personal data is voluntary. However, if you do not provide your personal data common activities might be delayed or impossible.

2. Processed data categories and legal basis of the processing

We process the following categories of your personal data on the basis of our prevailing legitimate interest (Article 6(1)(f) GDPR), which is to achieve the purposes set out under Point 1 above:

- Your full name
- Your email address and, if applicable, your web address
- If provided, your home address and / or your institutional address
- If provided, your function in the institution
- If provided, your phone number

3. Transfer of your personal data

- In specific cases to our publisher.

4. Retention periods

Your personal data will only be kept for as long as we reasonably consider necessary for achieving the purposes set out under Point 1 above and as is permissible under applicable law. We will, in any case, retain your personal data for as long as there are statutory retention obligations or potential legal claims are not yet time-barred.

5. Your rights in connection with your personal data

Under applicable law, you have, among others, the rights (under the conditions set out in applicable law):

- (i) to check whether and what kind of personal data we hold about you and to request copies of such data,
- (ii) to request correction, supplementation or deletion of your personal data that is inaccurate or processed in non-compliance with applicable requirements, and
- (iii) to request us to restrict the processing of your personal data,
- (iv) in certain circumstances, to object for legitimate reasons to the processing of your personal data or to revoke consent previously granted for the processing,
- (v) to request data portability,
- (vi) to know the identities of third parties to which your personal data are transferred, and
- (vii) to lodge a complaint with the competent authority.
